Water Conditions - about average

>>>Hex are here! With some warm, muggy days and 64 degree water temps, these huge mayflies have been making impressive appearances the last few nights. Last night (6/13) was the biggest hatch and it brought quite a few feeders to the surface. *Matt Dunn*

Big Manistee

Water Conditions - high

>>>Dry fly fishing was good until the storms rolled through and the water came up. Try nymphing and streamers until the levels return to normal again.

Muskegon

Water Conditions - about average

>>>Trout fishing has been good, particularly with nymphs and streamers. Isonychias and Caddis hatches have been good, but the fish are only keying in on them sporadically. *Phil Cusey*

Beaver Island >>> This has been the best start to carp season in a while. With a 40 pounder to hand already this year, plenty of 5-6lb incidental smallmouth and the vast turquoise flats and bright sunshine, Beaver Island is the place to be. *Kevin Morlock*
