Streamer fishing for trout was improved in the higher water, but mousing will be slow until the water clears a bit more.

*Water Conditions* - above average, steady

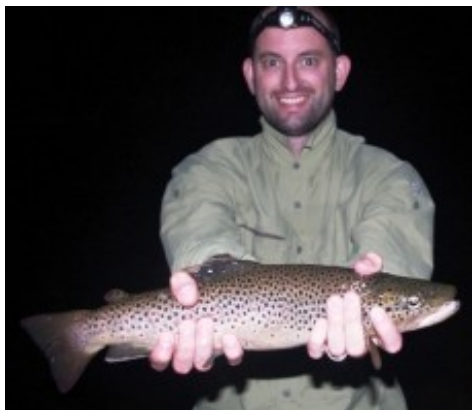
Again, with warm temperatures the trout fishing is slow. Smallmouth fishing has been good.
